Welcome to the 2010 USHA Annual Convention. This year we have another great program, with Six out-of-state speakers, along with USU faculty and other industry experts. We encourage you to read the following notes and changes about this year's Convention.

Date and Location: The convention will be held January 19-21, 2010. January 19: Field Tour (see details below) January 20-21: Annual Meetings and Trade Show at the following location-County Administration Building, rooms L700-L900, located at 100 East Center St., Provo.

Program: This year the Wednesday morning session will begin at 8:50 A.M.; the Thursday morning session will begin at 8:30 A.M.. Lunch will be provided on Wednesday Jan. 20 in room 211 of the old County Courthouse.

Utah Berry Growers Meeting: Those registered for the USHA meeting wishing to stay for the Utah Berry Growers Meeting on Thursday Afternoon are asked to pay a \$5.00 registration fee, which will cover lunch for that day. Alternatively, berry growers not wanting to attend the Tuesday or Wednesday activities can pay a single-day registration fee of \$20 that will cover the Thursday lunch.

Membership: A membership fee is \$40 when you register prior to the convention, and \$50 at the door. This fee covers attending the winter tour on Tuesday, the annual convention, and lunch on Wednesday. Display Space: Available at no charge, and you may begin the setup anytime after 7:00 A.M. on the 20th. Demand is high for this, so we encourage you to come early. Displays will occupy room L900 at the County Administration Building, adjacent to the conference rooms.

Goodfruit Grower: The block subscription to the Goodfruit Grower will be \$20 for those who have registered for the convention, and runs from April 2010 for one year.

Banquet: The annual banquet will be held 6:30 P.M. Wednesday evening (Jan. 20) at the Clarion Reception Center at 463 East 100 North in Payson. Please select on the registration form your preference of Roast Beef or Teriyaki Chicken. Tickets are \$20.00. If you prefer a vegetarian offering, please note that on the registration form and we will attempt to accommodate you.

Orchard Tour. The winter tour will be held Tuesday, January, 19 with tours, demonstrations and a good lunch. The Bus will depart Tuesday morning from the LDS meetinghouse at 100 S. 200 E. in Santaquin at 9:00 A.M.. Lunch will be served around noon. Directions: If coming from Provo, take the Santaquin exit off I-15, drive west along Main St. in Santaquin, turn left (south) at 200 East, drive one block to 100 South and turn right (west) and drive to the parking lot on the west side of the Church.
